1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO STIMULATE FAMILY TOGETHERNESS  
2 IN MONTANA"

3  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5  
6 **Section 1:** This bill will promote low budget programs such as games, sports and other family  
7 fun activities. They will schedule big events and encourage people to take their families to such  
8 activities.

9 **Whereas:** Studies show that younger teenagers turn out better the more time they spend with  
10 their families.

11  
12 **Section 2:** To promote family togetherness a Board of Teenagers Rehab will fund and support  
13 this bill.

14  
15 **Section 3:** This board will inform Montana families about the benefits of increased family time  
16 and broadcast information towards family time that will be broadcasted for fifteen minutes  
17 throughout every week on television, internet and commercials.

19 **Section 4:** A big function will be held in Helena for families all across the state. There will be a  
20 banquet and activities for the families to participate in. The fee for each family will be \$100.

21  
22 **Section 5:** This function will be supported by a Board of Teenagers Rehab.

23  
24 **Section 5:** If any broadcasting company fails to comply they will be fined \$100,000.

26 **Section 6:** This act is effective immediately upon passage.
