1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE ECONOMY THROUGH
2 STIFFENED WELFARE PROGRAMS AND TIME LIMITS IN THE CONCEPT OF
3 WELFARE; AND PROVIDING IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE"

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

7 NEW SECTION **Section 1. Action.** A person whom seeks to apply for welfare must hold a full
8 time job to receive benefits. If upon removal from job in any instance the person may have three
9 weeks to seek and apply after new job.

10 NEW SECTION **Section 2 Contest Rules.** Their will be a time limit on the workfare program
11 of eight months to continue to receive benefits. This will ensure that the person has a support
12 system to use their right to pursue happiness and basic needs of life's basic needs in order to
13 become a self supporting citizens. Administration of welfare programs can be returned to local
14 government when needed.

15 NEW SECTION **Section 4. Fiscal Note.** The act will come form general funding form taxation
16 in the start but will further be increasing general funding after passage through increased
17 economy and taxation of workers in program.

18 NEW SECTION **Section 5. Enactment Date** This bill will go into effect immediately upon
19 passage.
