8. 95%-100%=A or 4.00

9. 90%-94%=A- or 3.66

10. 87%-89%=B+ or 3.33

11. 83%-86%= B or 3.00

12. 80%-83%=B- or 2.66

13. 77%-79%=C+ or 2.33

14. 73%-76%= C or 2.00

15. 70%-72%=C- or 1.66

16. 67%-69%=D or 1.33

17. 63%-66%=D or 1.00

18. 60%-62%=D- or 0.66

19. 0%-59%=F or no credit
