1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE COMFORT IN PUBLIC

2 RESTROOMS."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 Section 1: Toilet paper used in public restrooms must be at least one-half millimeter thick.

5 Section 2: Toilet paper used in public restrooms may not be opaque or see-thru.

6 Section 3: Toilet paper used in public restrooms must have a CAMI (Coated Abrasive

7 Manufacturers Institute) Grit Designation level of 800 or higher.

8 Section 4: The toilet paper will be paid for by the owners of the land the restrooms are located

9 upon.

10 Section 5: If a citizen finds the toilet paper to be too thin or too abrasive they shall report the

11 location to the local health inspector.

12 Section 6: The local health inspector may then fine the owners of the public restroom \$150.00

13 which will go to the general fund.

14 Section 7: This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
