1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REFORM THE STOP SIGN LAW"

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 Section1: To allow drivers on the road to get to their desired destination faster while still being  
6 able to drive safely.

8 Section2: A stop sign shall not be put into place at a intersection unless it's able to pass a check  
9 list of requirements that goes as follows: It may only be put into a intersection that has a recorded  
10 account of being a blinded intersection, where most of the time there are cars parked preventing  
11 the vision of the oncoming drivers from being able to see. The stop sign must also be stationed in  
12 a area where there is a extremely large recorded account of car accidents (meaning anywhere  
13 from 5 to 10 accidents a year). As well as area's where there is a large number of speeding  
14 tickets given out.

16 Section3: Stop signs shall not be required to be put at intersections where the driver can see  
17 clearly in all three directions oncoming at least a block or more away.

19 Section4: This bill shall go into effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November, 2007.
