2 LICENSE APPLICANTS TO 16, AMENDING A.R.M. 24.156.2711"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **RULE 24.156.2711 A.R.M. IS AMENDED TO READ:**

- 8 (1) The board shall
- 9 license an applicant as an EMT at the appropriate level, if the applicant:
- 10 (a) successfully completes a board approved EMT course of instruction;
- 11 (b) possesses current NREMT registration for the appropriate level of
- 12 licensure or higher, except for EMT-Fs who have maintained continuous licensure
- 13 prior to January 1, 2004;
- 14 (c) provides all the information necessary to establish eligibility for licensure
- 15 according to the licensure requirements as specified by the board or its designee;
- 16 (d) possesses a high school diploma or equivalency or composite ACT score of 22 or SAT of
- 17 1540 (M, CR/V, W); and
- 18 (e) is ~~18~~ 16 years of age or older.

20 **EFFECTIVE DATE:** Amendments will become effective the first day of the next fiscal year
21 upon passage of this bill.
