1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "An act to protect employees and prospective employees  
2 from being fired or not being hired as a result of their tattoos."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 Section 1. The people of Montana can not be discriminated against by employers because  
7 of tattoos which they have.  
8

9 Section 2. Employers may discriminate if the tattoo is racist or vulgar.

11 Section 3. This bill becomes effective upon passage.
