1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO FIGHT CHILDHOOD OBESITY BY  
2 BANNING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF ALL SOFT DRINK PRODUCTS IN  
3 PUBLIC SCHOOLS."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

7 SECTION. **Section 1.** Discontinue the distribution and sale of all soft drink  
8 products in Montana Public Schools K-12.

9 SECTION. **Section 2.** Definition of soft drink.

10 (1) Soft drink is defined as any beverage containing more than 10% refined sugar in  
11 any form such as corn syrup products and byproducts.

12 (2) Soft drink is further defined as any beverage containing caffeine.

13 (3) Soft drink is further defined as any beverage containing carbonation.

14 SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** This bill will become effective within six  
15 months of passage.
