1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO NO LONGER HAVE A LIMIT OF

2 ABSENCES IN MONTANA HIGH SCHOOLS."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 Section 1: Students will not have a maximum number of days they are allowed to be absent from  
5 school without losing credit.

6 Section 2: Students will need to be excused from school with a parent or doctor's consent.

7 Section 3: If a student has missed more than ten days of a given class, they must score a 75  
8 percent or higher on the semester exam and have an 80 percent for the class as an average of  
9 work and tests taken.

- 10 • If the class that has been missed more than ten days does not give an exam at the end of
- 11 the semester, the student must have an 85 percent average in the class.

12 Section 4: This bill shall go into effect for the 2007-2008 school year.
