1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "To protect Designated Drivers from receiving punishment  
 2  
 3 from law enforcers because they are in the presence of intoxicated passengers."  
 4

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:  
 6

7 Section 1: To ensure that Designated Drivers are treated as protectors of human life and are  
 8  
 9 seen as responsible because they are not allowing Intoxicated persons to get behind the wheel  
 10  
 11 jeopardizing the lives of others. Therefore if it is proven that they have not been drinking  
 12  
 13 themselves they would be exempted from MIP's and/or DUI's.  
 14

15 Section 2: Definitions: "Intoxicated"- any person no matter age that has been impaired due  
 16  
 17 to alcohol. "Designated Driver"- one whose sole purpose is to ensure the lives of those who are  
 18  
 19 intoxicated by transporting them without being intoxicated themselves.  
 20

21 Section 3: This law will be overseen and put into play by all Law Enforcement agencies.  
 22

23 Section 4: This bill will be put into effect upon passage.
