1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW RESIDENTS OF  
2 YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK TO CLAIM MONTANA RESIDENCY"

3  
4 Whereas residents of Yellowstone National Park are residents of Wyoming despite some being  
5 less than five miles from the border of Montana and more directly affected by Montana  
6 legislature. Also those residents from Yellowstone who work in Montana must pay Montana  
7 income tax.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

10  
11 Section 1: Residents within 15 miles of the Montana Border in Yellowstone National Park  
12 would be able to claim residency in Montana if they so chose.

13  
14 Section 2: All those who chose to claim residency in Montana would be able to vote in Montana  
15 in the District of Park County Montana. Also residents would be able to receive driver's  
16 licenses, license plates.

17  
18 Section 3: Those claiming residency would also be required to pay all Montana taxes and subject  
19 to Montana laws.

20  
21 Section 4: This bill will become effective upon September 1, 2007.
