- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "CHANGING "NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND" TO FIT
- 2 MONTANA."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:
- 4 Section 1: No Child Left Behind will be discontinued in Montana until it is retooled to better fit
- 5 small states like Montana.
- 6 Section 2: The Montana education fund is \$227,424,402 Montana provides \$218,027,142 of this
- 7 fund. NCLB and other sources including local governments provide the remaining \$9,397,260.
- 8 Section 3: Any additional funding that is deemed necessary will be taken from the general fund.
- 9 Section 4: This bill will become effective at the beginning of the next fiscal year.
