1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW NONPUBLIC SCHOOL
2 STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN EXTRACURRICULAR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACTIVITIES"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 Section 1: Nonpublic school students shall be allowed to participate in their district public

7 school's extracurricular activities, including, but not limited to, sports, music ensembles, theatre,

8 and clubs.

9 Section 2 Definition: As used in this bill extracurricular activities are defined as school

10 approved and educational activities for the enjoyment of students that occur in and outside of the

11 regular school day.

12 Section 3: Nonpublic school students must meet the same residency requirements as set forth by

13 the school district.

14 Section 4: Students shall agree to and follow the same behavior, responsibility, participation

15 policies, physical eligibility, immunization, age eligibility, grade eligibility, attendance,

16 insurance, transportation policy, practice, and residency requirements as an enrolled public

17 school student.

18 Section 5: Any insurance provided by school districts for participants in extracurricular
19 activities shall be available to the nonpublic school student. Any additional premium shall be
20 paid by the student.

21 Section 6: The public school district shall require a signed permission slip from parent or
22 guardian of a nonpublic school student allowing the student to participate in extracurricular
23 activities.

24 Section 7: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2008-2009 school year.
