1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO MAKE IT MANDATORY FOR ALL HIGH
2 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES TO ATTEND TEEN PREVENTION PROGRAMS ANNUALLY
3 WITHIN THE STATE OF MONTANA"

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1:** Purpose: To raise awareness of teen prevention throughout the state of Montana.

7 **Section 2:** Definitions: Teen prevention: The stopping harmful activities among high school
8 teens, such as family crises, and suicide.

9 **Section 3:** All school employees within the state of Montana will be required to attend one teen
10 prevention program annually.

11 **Section 4:** Teen prevention programs will help the administration become aware, and be
12 increasingly able to notice, and stop harmful activities among teens.

13 **Section 5:** Upon enactment, the teen prevention programs will help create an increasingly sound
14 environment for teens.

15 **Section 6:** This bill will be enacted upon passage.
