1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED TO: "REIMBURSE STUDENTS FOR GAS

2 MONEY SPENT DRIVING TO AND FROM SCHOOL"

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 Section 1: The state of Montana will refund any Montana High School Student

5 who drives over fifteen miles to school, or else spends five dollars in a total trip

6 to school.

7 Section 2: School sponsored events and extra curricular activities are not included

8 in this reimbursement (example: driving to school for weekend games, plays,

9 meetings ect. Practices after school do however count).

10 Section 3: When applicants apply for this program they must provide information

11 such as mileage to and from school (checked by home address and school

12 address), proof of gas mileage (to be checked by a notary), and of course valid ID

13 for whichever individual will be driving.

14 Section 4: Amount of money needed will be determined according to mileage.

15 Checks will be received in the mail each week in the amount needed. (Holidays

16 and federal days in which schools receive off will be reduced from the check).

17 Section 5: This extra money will be received from the General Budget.

18 Section 6: This bill will be effective upon passage.
