1A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "Anaphylactic Shock Prevention"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

**Section 1.**

Restaurants and dining facilities are defined as a business that sells food for profit to customers.

Anaphylaxis is defined as a sudden, severe allergic reaction, sometimes followed by death, characterized by a sharp drop in blood pressure, urticaria, and breathing difficulties that is caused by exposure to a foreign substance.

**Section 2.**

All restaurants and dining facilities in the State of Montana are required to label any food items in their menu that have been known to cause anaphylaxis or contain ingredients that have been known to cause anaphylaxis, such as tree nuts, eggs, peanuts, wheat, seafood, dairy products, and soy. The label will be clear and readable to all customers who wish to know this information.

**Section 3.**

This bill will be enacted two years after it is passed.
