1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "An Act For Mandatory Drug Testing For All Montana
2 Public High Schools"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 Section 1: A mandatory random drug testing for all of Montana's public high schools. One third
7 of each student's would be tested at random once a month.

8
9 Section 2: The purpose of drug testing is to rid Montana's schools of the drug use rate among
10 students. Problems with drugs such as marijuana and methamphetamines have plagued
11 Montana's youth for far too long.

13 Section 2: The drug testing is an initiative to lower the percent of teenage drug use.

15 Section 3: The funding for this bill will come from the Montana state general fund.

17 Section 4: This bill will take affect upon the following school year.
