1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO HAVE THE STATE OF MONTANA PUT

2 A 7% SALES TAX ON TAXABLE ITEMS"

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 Section 1: By January 1, 2009, the state of Montana would put a sales tax on all taxable items in
5 all areas of Montana.

6 Section 2: This sales tax would go towards Montana's infrastructure and education funding.

7 Section 3: Tourists will have to pay for driving on Montanan's roads and would also help go to a
8 cause that Montanan's pay for anytime they travel outside of the state.

9 Section 4: All taxable items in the state of Montana would have a seven percent sales tax placed
10 on them. Taxable items being items that the government does not already receive money for.

11 Section 5: This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
